Minutes Approval	• February 20, 2020
Presentations	 Matt provided an update on the COVID-19. In a transition phase of reopening while trying to reduce cases at the same time. Lots of the new cases are being discovered through contact tracing. Working on getting more wastewater testing sites up and running. The current sites are coinciding with case counts. Matt Kelley will be taking over as the incident commander. The Health Department is interested in increasing testing, but want to make sure it is valuable. The Health Department has no insight on when Phase 3 might occur. To their knowledge there is no set criteria for this change. Betty Kalakay provided initial feedback from the Initial Response Review for COVID-19. She has 50 responses so far and feedback is still being accepted. Betty is working on consolidating it and will distribute it.
Action Items	 Patrick reported that despite somewhat vague and disparate guidance on local government reimbursements, it appears that any local government agency is an eligible sub-applicant. Patrick is working with Gallatin County on what that process is. More information to come.
Updates	 Patrick and Kevin reported that the ballistic PPE for the MCI project is here. Additional triage kits have also been procured and will be distributed. The mass transport bus is at the prison waiting in line to get painted. 2020 Rural Fire Operating plan is adopted and posted for review. Summer Active Killer Exercise was cancelled. Kevin is working with MSU to see what the future opportunity to hold on campus will be. Unknown when that will be rescheduled. A bunch of training courses have been cancelled due to COVID. This courses will likely get backed up come this next winter. Let Emergency Management know what your agency priorities are so we can focus on those courses.
