Presentations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kiera Pattison provided a lessons learned of an incident at Bozeman Health with an individual with a knife intending harm to themselves. Lessons learned included that their emergency procedure for any weapon used the language “Active Shooter”, which introduced confusion. The individual ended up having a second weapon after the first knife was discarded and the situation seemed stabilized. Multiple mixed situations were relayed to 911, many by people with no first hand knowledge of the situation. Communication with employees and visitors across the campus was challenging. The full AAR document is attached. Robert Hart with the National Weather Service provided an overview of the current season outlooks as well as changes to the geographic boundaries that messaging will be changing to this fall. It is focused on Rescue Task Forces and planning to consist of multiple reps through scenarios. The October event will be shifted to a training course with an actual exercise at a later date. Patrick provided the annual Floodplain update on behalf of Sean O’Callaghan. Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Patrick introduced Jay Pape who started two weeks ago in the Preparedness and Mitigation Manager position. Gallatin County has funding for a mailer to the residences that are located in the Wildland Urban Interface WUI notifying them of that, how they can find more information about what that means, how to

	<p>request a home assessment and available mitigation funding. The expectation is that the first mailing will go out this fall with a second round in the spring.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • North Gallatin Front Wildfire Mitigation Project was presented as an application for the Community Wildfire Defense Grant. The wildfire mitigation grant would provide cost match for private lang owners to conduct work on their property. • Madison County has signed the interlocal to consolidate the emergency management functions in the Madison County portion of Big Sky into the Gallatin County program. Gallatin County will be signing the agreement next week. This will eliminate • Gallatin County has provided funding to hire a consultant to evaluate emergency medical services in Gallatin County and provide modeling of what the demand is likely to look like in the future and recommendations of what a sustainable and appropriately configured system could look like. A small work group has developed the deliverables for an RFP and we expect that to be on the street soon to allow a consultant to begin work this fall. • The Middle Creek Early Warning system is being upgraded this fiscal year to replace the current radio system and county maintained hardware with a hosted satellite based platform. This will likely reduce hardware costs and heavily reduce the maintenance needs.
