Patrick has started working on some agreements to access regional USAR teams in Idaho and Washington. Patrick asked for feedback on the viability and support for trying to form a base USAR capability in Montana. Everyone seemed to think that was a good idea. Patrick reported that the county attorney’s office will be reviewing evacuation authorities so we can accurately describe the relationship between law enforcement’s duties and the authority spelled out in Title 10.
Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grants <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Emergency Management was successful in a homeland security award for Cyber Security in the amount of \$80,623. This project will replace the network infrastructure and door locks at the Coordination Center. It will also create a microwave data link between Gallatin County and Butte. We were not successful in our requests for Mass Notification, Amateur Radios, or Variable Message Sign projects. Emergency Management was successful in a funding request from the Big Sky Resort Tax Board for \$20,000 to purchase a

	Variable Message Sign for in Big Sky. This will replace the HARP that was previously there.
