<b>Minutes Approval</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>February 25, 2016</li></ul>
<b>Presentations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Ron Edwards from Big Sky Water and Sewer was unable to make it to have an AAR on the Yellowstone Club Spill. The group did have a discussion among ourselves on some lessons learned from the county's side. First, when talking with other agencies it is probably good to define what a given role means so that everyone involved has the same definition. Second, the county could have helped Big Sky Water and Sewer with the information flow, but they didn't contact us and we didn't realize they were as involved as they were. In retrospect emergency management should have reached out to Big Sky Water and Sewer. The observation was also made that DEQ initially didn't appear to have the same level of concern as the local agencies for getting ahead of the information curve.</li></ul>
<b>Action Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Patrick went over the areas where clarifications were added for PEO's role in evacuations. There were no concerns expressed.</li><li>The Hazard Mitigation Plan is scheduled for revision in 2017. It has been proposed that we incorporate the Community Wildfire Protection Plan into the Hazard Mitigation Plan. There was some discussion about this and the agreement was to try and combine the two.</li></ul>
