**RE: Spill Closure Approval [CVID #18957]**

Dear Mr. Custer:

On January 25, 2016, the Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report that approximately 50 gallons of asphalt oil spilled to the ground as the result of a semi-truck accident along Highway 191 near mile marker 37, Gallatin County, Montana.

On May 18, 2016, information was received from you that outlined the cleanup activities. Contaminated soils were removed from the roadside and disposed of at the Gallatin County Landfill, Logan, Montana. Soil sample results indicate that this site has been remediated.

Based upon the information provided, ENFD has determined the assessment and cleanup to be satisfactory and is closing the spill at this time. However, ENFD reserves the right to request that additional activities be conducted should information become available to warrant it.
