Dear Ms. Geavais:

On April 20, 2016, the Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report that approximately 20 gallons of gasoline spilled from a semi-truck fuel tank onto the pavement along Interstate 90, near mile marker 305, Gallatin County, Montana.

On June 24, 2016, information was received from Best Rate Towing, on your behalf that outlined the cleanup activities. The spill was cleaned using floor dry and disposed of at the Logan Landfill in Three Forks, Montana.

Based upon the information provided, ENFD has determined the assessment and cleanup to be satisfactory and is closing the spill at this time. However, ENFD reserves the right to request that additional activities be conducted should information become available to warrant it.
