**RE: Spill Closure Approval [CVID #19051]**

Dear Mr. Bromann:

On March 21, 2016, the Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report that an unknown amount of hydraulic oil spilled to the ground from a broken hydraulic hose in December 2015. The spilled hydraulic oil is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> lot on the right from the Corner of Anaconda and Paintbrush Lane, Big Sky.

On April 29, 2016, information was received from you that outlined the cleanup activities. Approximately 8.64 tons of contaminated media was removed and disposed of at the Logan Landfill in Three Forks, Montana.

Based upon the information provided, ENFD has determined the assessment and cleanup to be satisfactory and is closing the spill at this time. However, ENFD reserves the right to request that additional activities be conducted should information become available to warrant it.
