Dear Mr. Rasoul,

The Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report of an accident that involved a Western Lines semi-truck spilling approximately 10 gallons of engine oil on July 20, 2017. The accident occurred at the intersection of Interstate 90 and Interstate 15, near Rocker, Montana.

On September 11, 2017, a cleanup statement was received from Resource Technologies, Inc., which outlined the cleanup activities. Contaminated soils were removed from the accident location and disposed of at the Logan Landfill, Gallatin County, Montana.
