To Whom It May Concern:

The Enforcement Program (ENF) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report of a May Trucking semi-truck accident that caused the release of an unknown amount of diesel fuel on Interstate 90 Westbound, Mile Marker 320.4, Gallatin County, Montana. The semi-truck accident occurred on December 13, 2017.

On April 10 and July 23, 2018, reports were received from Best Rate Towing and Repair Inc. which outlined the cleanup activities. A total of three excavation activities took place; contaminated soil was excavated from the site and disposed of at the Logan Landfill in Manhattan, MT. The soil confirmation sampling results provided on July 23<sup>rd</sup> and the additional information submitted indicates the contamination has been adequately removed.
