The Enforcement Program (ENF) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report of a Johnny B Transport, LLC, semi-truck accident that caused the release of 550 gallons of asphalt to the ground along Highway 20, near mile marker 3, Gallatin County, Montana. The semi-truck accident occurred on February 2, 2018.

On May 30, 2018, a report was received from you that outlined the cleanup activities. Released asphalt and contaminated soils were removed from the site and transported to the HK Contractors Willow Creek Pit, in Idaho Falls, Idaho, for recycling. Soil sample indicate that the release has been adequately remediated.
