**RE: Spill Closure Approval [CVID 20823]**

Dear Mr. Heap,

On August 7, 2018, the Enforcement Program (ENF) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report of a Glacier Mountain Transport semi-truck accident which spilled an unknown amount of diesel fuel on Highway 191 near Mile Marker 62 in Gallatin County, Montana.

On October 22, 2018, a cleanup statement was received from P.J. Johnson from Best Rate Towing, which outlined the cleanup activities. No diesel fuel was spilled, however no more than 20 gallons of hydraulic fluid were spilled; the spill was contained and the road surface was cleaned, contaminated soil was removed and then disposed of at Logan Landfill in Gallatin County, Montana.
