The Enforcement Program (ENF) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received a report of approximately 8,000 gallons of asphalt cement was released to the environment from a DMN Enterprise Inc. semi-truck accident. The accident occurred along Interstate 90, near mile marker 309, Bozeman, Gallatin County, Montana.

On March 18, 2019, a report was received from Kenny Custer with Idaho Asphalt Supply, which outlined the cleanup activities. Asphalt and contaminated soils were removed from the site and disposed of at the Gallatin County Landfill. Soil sampling results indicate that the site has been adequately remediated.
