The Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the Montana Department of Transportation's (MDT) March 2, 2015 letter report (Report) summarizing activities conducted in response to the above-referenced incident.

Based on review of the information provided in the Report, ENFD is satisfied with actions conducted by MDT and is closing this spill file. Closure of this spill file may not resolve claims of third parties who may be adversely impacted by this spill.

ENFD is closing this spill file based on analytical results that did not identify petroleum hydrocarbons at concentrations exceeding DEQ's Tier 1 Risk-Based Corrective Action, Risk-Based Screening Levels applicable to this spill site.
