The Enforcement Division (ENFD) of the Montana Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed the September 22, 2015 letter report discussing the August 27, 2015 site inspection of the spill site. The letter was prepared and submitted on behalf of Bozeman Site Services, LLC (Bozeman) by Team Jenkins, LLC (Jenkins).

Based on review all supporting documentation discussing assessment and remedial actions conducted in response the magnesium chloride spill, ENFD is not requiring any further action and is closing this spill file. ENFD does, however, reserve the right to request that further assessment or remedial activities be conducted if information is presented that indicates state waters were impacted as a result of this spill.

Closure of this spill file may not resolve claims of third parties who may be adversely impacted by this spill.
